WHAT IS gMG?

Generalized myasthenia gravis (gMG) is the most common form of the chronic rare autoimmune, neuromuscular disease myasthenia gravis (MG).

gMG may cause unpredictable symptoms that can lead to weakness throughout the body. gMG weakness can disrupt everyday functions, including seeing, walking, chewing, swallowing, and breathing.
